

RESOLUTION NO. 871

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
CRESTLINE-LAKE ARROWHEAD WATER AGENCY
DECLARING A STAGE 2 WATER SHORTAGE ALERT**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Crestline-Lake Water Agency has adopted Ordinance No. 66 restricting the use of water during threatened or existing water shortage conditions in the Agency; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 66 provides that the Agency's Board of Directors may declare a Stage 2 Alert triggering certain mandatory water conservation measures within the Agency when the State Water Resources Control Board has imposed restrictions on the use of water within the Agency, following a public hearing by this Board on the proposed declaration of a Stage 2 Alert; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California has declared that drought conditions exist in California, has authorized the State Water Resources Control Board to impose mandatory water conservation measures, and the State Board has adopted mandatory measures that apply throughout California, including the boundaries of the Agency; and


WHEREAS, following publication of notice in a newspaper of general circulation within the Agency in the manner provided by law, on March 3, 2022 this Board conducted a public hearing to consider declaring a Stage 2 Alert pursuant to Ordinance No. 66 to impose certain restrictions on the use of water for specified purposes within the Agency's retail service area, consistent with the restrictions imposed by the State Board throughout California; and

WHEREAS, at said public hearing, this Board accepted and has considered all testimony and comments offered on the proposed declaration of a Stage 2 Alert;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency does hereby declare a Stage 2 Alert within the Agency's retail service area to impose the water use restrictions identified for a Stage 2 alert as set forth in Ordinance No. 66, a copy of which is on file with the Agency, is posted on the Agency's web site, and is available for review upon request..

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Board of Directors shall arrange for the publication of this resolution in a newspaper of general circulation within the Agency as provided in Ordinance No. 66.
